Building on our forward trajectory, student achievement will continue to grow. Students and staff will identify with our Allis Scholar Identity in order to build learning partnerships with students as they review, reflect and adjust their 5 or 10 day reading plans.

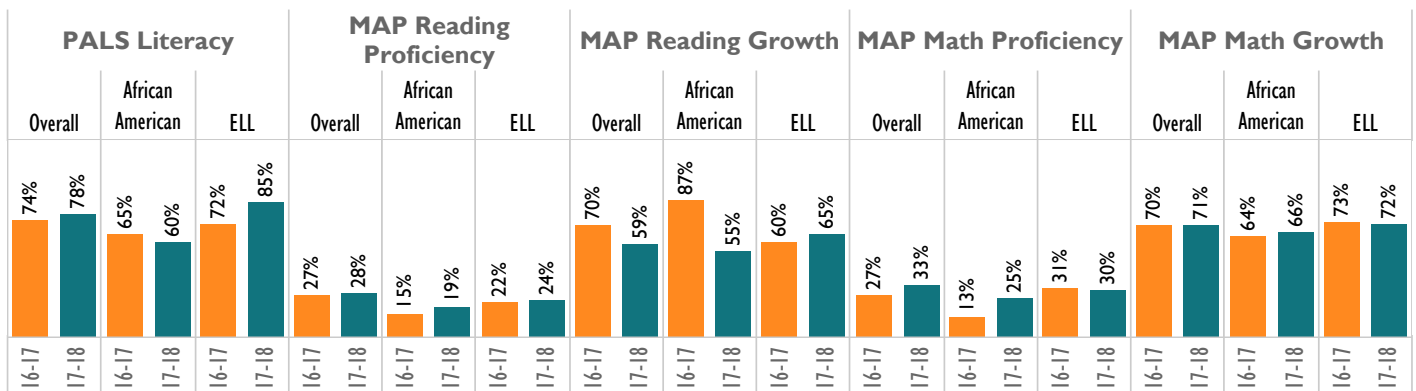

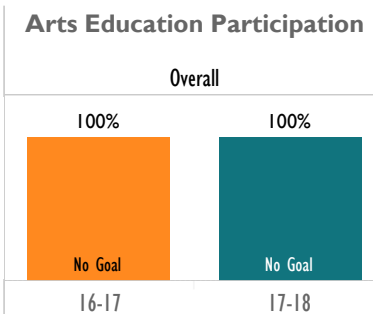
